Highlighting the roster are two legendary '80s performers that no wrestling fan would have likely predicted: Hulk Hogan (who currently works for WWE's competition, TNA) and "Macho Man" Randy Savage (who had a notorious falling out with WWE and hasn't appeared in a WWE game for more than 15 years). Included in the legends portion of the lineup is a who's-who of

pro-wrestling history, including the Ultimate Warrior, Bret "The Hitman" Hart, Sgt. Slaughter, Jake "The Snake" Roberts, "Rowdy" Roddy Piper, "Superfly" Jimmy Snuka, Eddie Guerrero, Ricky "The Dragon" Steamboat, Andre the Giant, and The Rock. Complementing the classic superstars are modern-day grapplers such as Randy Orton, Triple H, Sheamus, Rey Mysterio, Big Show, Edge, John Morrison, Kane, Kofi Kingston, Jack Swagger, and John Cena.
